HOW DO I GET MY PENSION INFORMATION?

If you're looking for information regarding your pension the city has a website that does just that, it's called webCOPS,

https://www.nyc.gov/content/nycppf/pages/webcops, it is part of the New York City Police Pension Fund system. WebCOPS is a secure website that supplies you with basic information. However, you can request a variety of information from the site; members can request pension statements, loan estimates and tax statements.

To begin, you first need to call the Pension Section at (646) 905-5596, they must activate your account and mail you a Pin # for registration, please make sure they have your current address on file.

Once you receive your Pin #, please note that there is an expiration on your Pin #, go to the website and create an account. While on the webpage just do the following:

- Hit "Create and account and log directly into your webCOPS Member Self-Service portal" It will bring you to sign-in page.
- Hit the "Register" button
- Accept their terms of agreement
- Select "Primary Member"
- Now fill in your information, you will need your SS# and Tax# to complete the form.
- Hit "I am Human" button and answer the question.
- Hit the "Next" Button.
- Select your Security questions. Answer the questions and write them down for future reference.
- Hit the "Next" Button.
- The next page requires you to enter your Pin # mailed by the Pension Section.
- Hit the "Complete" Button.
- Set up Two Factor Authorization. It asks for your phone number and email.
- It asks if you want paperless notification or mailed to your address, select your preference.
- Hit "Finish" and then you're registered and now you're in their document page. You are done.

You should be registered. Any problems call (646) 905-5596.

NOTIFICATION TO SERGEANTS BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION HEALTH AND WELFARE (SBA-HW)

CHANGE OF SOCIAL STATUS

Members are responsible for notifying the SBA Health and Welfare Fund (SBA-HW) as soon as possible if they have a change in social status, divorce, or Termination of Domestic Partnership or death of a spouse. A social status change directly impacts the eligibility of spouses, domestic partners and any dependents who became eligible based on the former relationship ex: stepchildren.

There are some members who correctly have notified the Office of Labor Relations (NYC-OLR) but neglected to dually notify our Health and Welfare Fund when a change of social status occurs. Most concerning is there are members who have completely "missed the mark" by not notifying either party. These oversights have led to the present NYC-OLR Domestic Eligibility Verification Audit (DEVA) and most importantly our SBA-HW fund wrongly continuing coverage of the ineligible spouse, Domestic Partner and any enrolled stepchildren whose eligibility is based upon the existing relationship.

Members must provide legal documentation of this change i.e. domestic partnership termination certificate or divorce paperwork (1st and last page) once a divorce is finalized or a domestic partnership is terminated.

FailuretonotifytheSBAHealthandWelfareFund leaves members responsible for all misapplied benefit costs/expenses generated by their former spouses/domestic partners/dependents due to their continued benefit usage.

These former dependents are eligible for SBA COBRA Coverage which is funded by the eligible plan participant.

BENEFICIARY CHANGES

Retired Sergeants are fortunate to have the opportunity to retire early in our lives and in many cases, relocate to far and away places. With this advantage comes the potential for life-changing events that alter or conflict with choices made at our earlier time of retirement. One of these decisions is "beneficiaries" chosen for SBA provided benefits such as the \$5,000.00 Plan A Benefit or the \$4,000.00 Lifetime Member Mortuary Benefit. A change in social status or a beneficiary death can necessitate a recipient change. Recently, at the Sergeants Benevolent Association, we have been placed in challenging administrative positions due to members' failure to maintain up to date beneficiaries. This problem becomes very unpleasant at the sad time of a member's death when intended or chosen beneficiaries are being challenged by beneficiaries of record or there is no beneficiary on file. We strongly recommend that members confirm current beneficiaries particularly those that have sustained a life changing event such as a death of a loved one, divorce or any changes that potentially have an impact on earlier beneficiary choices.

RENEWING YOUR NYC PISTOL LICENSE-RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS (LEO)

If you have a Pistol License to carry prior to September 1, 2022 and are renewing your license, you will need to:

ATTEND A TRAINING CLASS OF 16 HRS. OF CLASSROOM TRAINING AND 2 HRS. OF LIVE FIRE

UNLESS YOU

Have an HR218 Qualification between the dates of Sept. 1, 2017 to August 31, 2022

OR

Retired After September 1, 2017

Submit your "OLD" HR218 Card with your License renewal in the folder marked" Proof of 16 HR Training"

<u>Retirees who retired on or after September 1, 202</u>2. If they were employed/Active between September 1, 2017, through August 31,2022, are not required to provide any additional proof (training or HR218) to renew their Concealed Carry Weapon Permit.

Please note that a valid HR218 is a key requirement in retaining and carrying your weapon when you do not satisfy the CCW renewal requirements.

Routinely, retired members will receive a mailed notice from the NYPD License Division, three (3) months prior to their current permit expiring, advising them on how to apply for their renewal and what requirements are mandated.

If a member switches from a Concealed Carry Weapon Permit to a Premise Permit, the member may switch back to a CCW permit if they can now satisfy the requirements. However, this conversion cannot take place until the next scheduled permit renewal date (usually 3 years).
